ITINERARY

DAY 1

Parents deliver children to catch 7:15am hovercraft
Coach collection from Southsea
Visit Thames Barrier Museum
Boat trip from Greenwich to Westminster – Thames River Cruise
Packed lunch from home
Collection by coach and delivery to hotel, Meininger Hotel, Hyde Park, bed and breakfast
Coach to Restaurant for evening meal at Fire and Stone
Walk to Prince Edward Theatre , Old Compton Street to see Aladdin

Coach back to hotel

DAY 2

Breakfast
Visit The National History Museum,
Walk along the South bank via The Monument (Great Fire of London),Globe Theatre, St Pauls Cathedral and the Millennium Bridge
Lunch (packed lunch provided)
London Eye flight
Coach returns to Southsea
Return IOW on 8:00pm hovercraft for collection by parents (time to be confirmed)

The overall cost of this trip is £230.

ROOMS

The children will sleep in boy or girl dormitories and the staff rooms are near the dorms so are easily accessible if necessary and children can be monitored as needed.

LUNCH/SNACKS

Lunch is not provided on the first day therefore we ask that children take a small backpack/rucksack on Monday 5 June containing a packed lunch and drinks and a waterproof coat. On Tuesday 6 June we have organised for the hotel to supply a packed lunch for the children.

Also, on Tuesday we do not get home until late and with only a packed lunch to sustain them the children will need snacks and drinks to keep them going. We will have opportunity to visit McDonalds before the coach journey home, so we recommend that the children put aside a small amount of spending money for this.
