Obstacle Course

Complete with bouldering walls, monkey bar climb, cargo nets, balance beams and lots more, the elements get more challenging as the activity progresses.



Abseiling

Instructors carefully support and guide each child to navigate their way slowly down the wall to the rapturous applause of their classmates, bringing a great sense of achievement.



Orienteering

Children must navigate their way around the centre finding various checkpoints, working as a team and using only a map. Orienteering helps participants develop important initiative, leadership and teamwork skills.



Jacobs Ladder

Children will have to effectively communicate with each other, discuss their options, weigh them up and decide on the best course of action. This activity encourages problem solving at its very best.



Nightline

Nightline is a sensory deprivation exercise in which pupils are blindfolded throughout the activity. Children navigate their way through a series of obstacles and mazes as a group, relying heavily on the trust and the support of each other.



3G Swing

This high adrenaline activity encourages individuals to set their own goals and challenge their limits, whilst building trust with their teammates. The group work together to hoist one participant in a harness up in the air on our 3G swing, as high or low as they like.



Problem Solving

Children work their way around purpose-built problem solving parks, which incorporate a range of problems and puzzles. This activity targets teamwork, leadership and communication skills.
