- Outdoor equipment: balls, hoops, balancing, hop scotch etc.

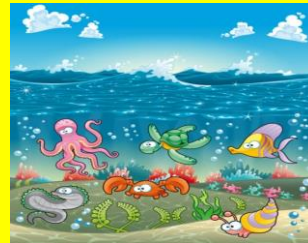
